

Cookie Question TYPO3 extension

Cookie Question denotes the TYPO3 extension with extension key "cookie_question".

CookieQuestion denotes the JavaScript framework Cookie Question is based upon.

cookie question denotes the visual HTML element presented to the frontend user.

Cookie Question can be used to fulfill legal requirements regarding user information and acknowledge. Such is done by showing the user of a web site a hint that cookies are used and require acknowledge through clicking a HTML element (e.g. a button) or optionally pressing the space bar. Once acknowledged the cookie question does not appear anymore.

For example Google requires web page providers that use Google AdSense and/or DoubleClick to explicitly inform their web page visitors in the European Union (EU) and acknowledge their agreement; the EU Commission has released a so called "Cookie-Guideline" that also requires to inform users about cookies used on web pages as TYPO3 does.

Cookie Question is based on the lightweight standalone JavaScript framework CookieQuestion.

That framework defines so called themes which specify visual presentation and behaviour of the cookie question functionality.

All details about that framework including hints about modifying and creating own themes are part of the CookieQuestion framework documentation, which is available at <https://ContemporaryCodes.com/cookieQuestionFramework/>.

Cookie Question works out-of-the-box once installed and enabled. The theme to use can be set in the extension configuration, individually for desktop, tablet and phone devices. Nine themes are predefined and, as explained in the framework documentation, own themes can be created and used.

To change the presented texts of the cookie question look at the file CookieQuestionTheme_[name of theme].js. Those theme files should be minimized. A suitable JavaScript minimizer can be found at <https://ContemporaryCodes.com/jsmin/>.
